ENGLISH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

In the case of a candidate whose native language is other than English, the following are the minimum acceptable. For certain subject areas there may be additional requirements.

•	British Council International English Language Testing Systems (IELTS)	- Average Score of 6 or above, and for each component 5 or above
•	Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English	- Grade C or better
•	Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English	- Grade C or better
•	English for Speakers of Other languages (ESOL) (Pitman Examinations Institute (PEI))	- Advanced, Pass
•	EUROCERT	- (See TOEFL)
•	Examination in Languages for International Communication (ELIC) (Institute of Linguists Educational Trust (IOL))	- Pass the Intermediate Diploma
•	International GSCE English as Second Language (Cambridge)	- Grade C or Better, based on Extended Curriculum
•	Hong Kong Certificate of Education	- English Language except (syllabus A) Standard Grade A, B and C
•	London Chamber of Commerce English for Business Examination	- Third Level
•	London Chamber of Commerce English for Commerce Examination	- Third Level
•	NEAB (JMB) Test in English (Overseas) - up to June 1989	- Grades 1, 2 and 3
•	NEAB (JMB) Test in English for Speakers of Other Languages – from March 1990	- Pass
•	Oxford – ARELS Examination (Higher Level)	- Distinction
•	Oxford International Business English Certificate	- Pass
•	Test in English for Educational Purposes (TEEP)	- Average Grade of 6 or above
•	TOEFL (American Test of English as Foreign Language)	- 550 or above – Paper based 213 or above – Computer based
•	Trinity College London Integrated Skills For Life (ISE)	- Level III
•	University of London GCE O Level Syllabus B in English Language	- Grade C or better
•	University of London Certificate of Attainment in English (Graded Tests)	- Level 5
