

As part of your application to BA (Hons) Graphic Arts & Moving Image at UWS we are pleased to invite you to attend an interview.

There will be an introduction to the programme with a chance to ask questions of the programme staff and then a short one to one interview. The process may take up to 3hrs.

Please remember that you are required to bring a portfolio of work with you to your interview session. Your Portfolio can include drawing, painting, printmaking, 3D, collage, textiles, digital imagery. Your portfolio can be in a digital format, for example on your iPad/tablet, or laptop, or a traditional portfolio is acceptable too. Please bring the portfolio of work in either physical form or on a laptop or tablet. **NOTE: We are unable to plug in external USB devices to our equipment due to cyber security reasons.**

A maximum of 12 pieces and examples of work showing some proficiency in using digital media applications such as Adobe Creative Suite or similar is recommended. Please be prepared to briefly discuss why and how you produced the creative work in your folio.

Applicants who do not bring their portfolio will be asked to reschedule their appointment.

Please refer to UCAS Hub for your interview date and time. You have the option to either accept, decline or request an alternative time slot. Please note that if you choose to decline your interview slot, your application will be rejected and you will no longer be eligible for this programme. If you request an alternative time slot where possible another will be communicated to you again via UCAS Hub.
