Payment plans, designed to help you to spread the cost of a module are available at the point of formal enrolment.

- £630

- Initial registration and consultation fee (non refundable) = £100
  - The cost of making the actual APL/APEL claim is £100 per module worth of credit awarded. Therefore the cost of an award of one module will be £100, an award of six will be £600 **in addition** to the non-refundable initial consultation and registration fee.
