

Working at UWS

Core Benefits

In addition to excellent terms and conditions we offer competitive holiday allowances, together with automatic enrolment into either the Strathclyde Pension Fund or the Scottish Teachers Superannuation Scheme. We also offer access to a wide range of training and development opportunities across the University.

Healthy Working Lives

UWS holds the Healthy Working Lives Gold Award. UWS encourages both staff and students to be as active as possible and offers Sports facilities to allow this. We operate a Cycle to Work Programme which enables staff to get a tax free bike through monthly salary sacrifice payments.
