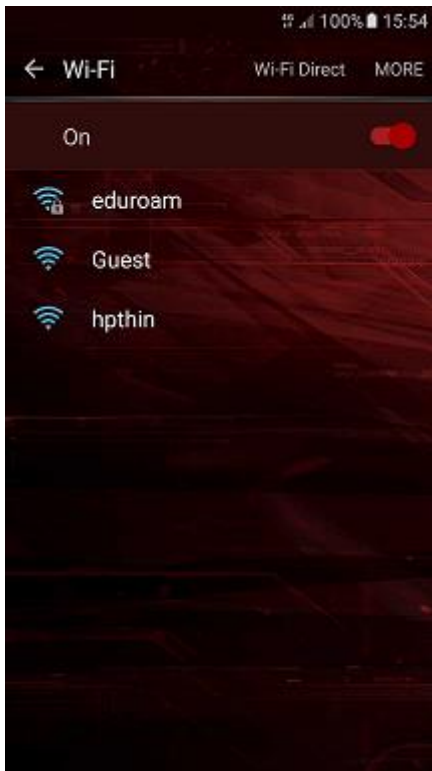
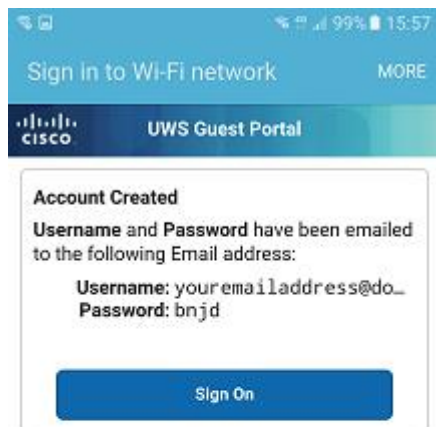
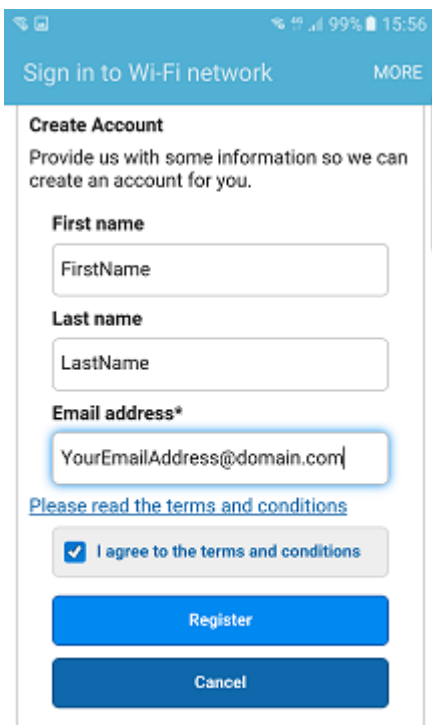


## Connect to Guest Wi-Fi

1. Connect your device to the Guest SSID.

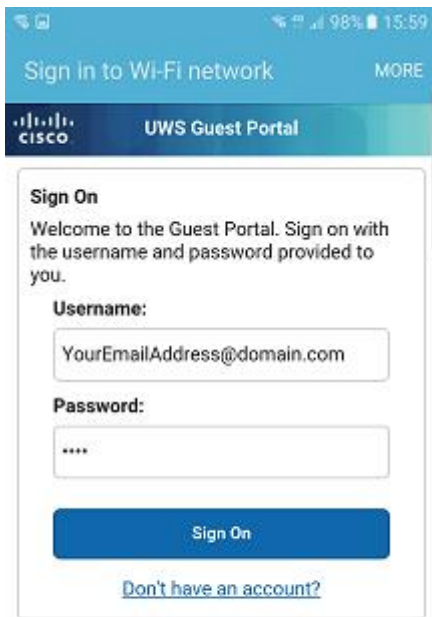


The logon portal will appear. If you already have login details proceed to step B. Otherwise click on **Don't have an account**

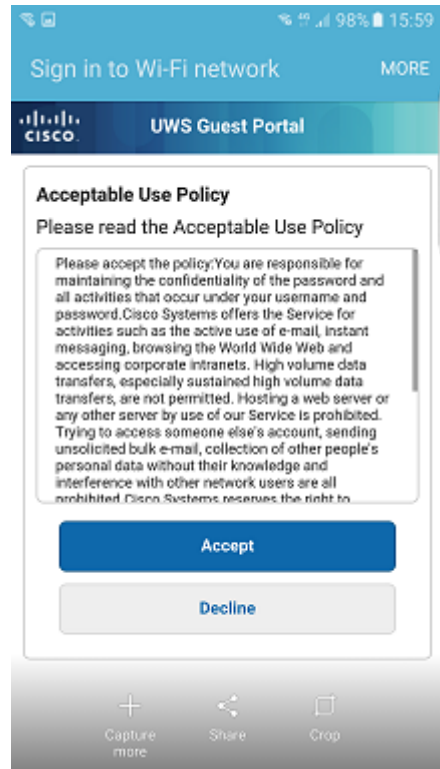


Your username and password will be shown on screen and will also be emailed to you. Take note of your details and click **Sign on** to continue.

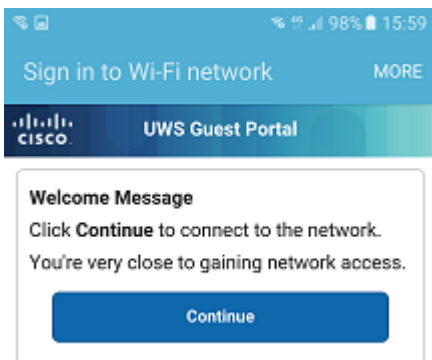
You will be asked to enter your details - enter your first name, last name and email address, click **I agree to the term and conditions** then click **Register**.

Click **Accept** to accept the Acceptable Use Policy.






