

Download Interlibrary Loan Copies from BL On Demand

You will receive an email from the British Library that has a link to download the copy. The email will be from noreply@bldss.bl.uk and the subject will include “**Ready for download**”.

You should open your document with [Adobe Reader](#). If your browser has a built-in PDF viewer, such as Google Chrome's, you will need to disable it in order to download and view your document.

To view your document in Adobe Reader you will need to enter your British Library On Demand username and password. You need to [register for On Demand](#) before you can view your document or [reset your username or password](#) if you have forgotten either of them.

To view British Library DRM Lite documents, you need to install Adobe Reader X or later.

Check you have everything you need to view your document by downloading a test document below.



Click on **Download your document**.

If you are using Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox, you will be asked where you would like the file to be saved to. Save the file to your Student drive or a USB drive if you are on campus, or to a folder that you can find later if you are using your own computer.

If you are using Google Chrome, the file will most probably download to the Downloads folder. Go to Windows Explorer to access your Downloads folder. Move the file from your Downloads folder to a folder that you can find later.

If you are using Safari, the file will download to the Downloads folder. Move the file from your Downloads folder to a folder that you can find later.

For downloads to mobile devices, please follow the instructions on your device to access the file from where it has downloaded to.

After download, go to the folder that you have moved the downloaded file to.

Double click on the file to open it. The file will open with Adobe Acrobat Reader. Please note you must have Adobe Acrobat Reader X or later versions installed on your computer to open the file. The file will not open with any other PDF viewer.

A log in prompt will appear. Enter your BL On Demand username and password to open the file.



You will need to enter these details every time you open the file, unless you check the 'Remember me on this computer' box. Please **DO NOT** check this box if you are accessing the file on a shared computer.

You can print **one copy only** of the file.

You can download the file using the link in the email unlimited number of times to more than one device for 30 days from the date of the email. The download link will expire after 30 days.

Once you have downloaded the file, it will be locked to your BL On Demand username and password and **only you can access it.**

You will be able to open the file that you have downloaded for up to 3 years from the date of the email. Please note that you must be connected to the internet to open the file.
