Unreasonable decision	• The decision made by one of the committees/panel was unreasonable, in that the committee/panel in reaching a decision took into consideration something which they ought to have disregarded or disregarded something which they ought to have considered.
Excessive or unreasonable penalty	The penalty levied by one of the committees/panel was excessive or unreasonable.

Please note that you must submit this form within 10 working days from the notification date which informed you of the decision against which you are appealing.

You must be clear with the grounds you are citing as an appeal form submitted with grounds not listed above will not be passed to the Senate Appeal Committee for consideration.
