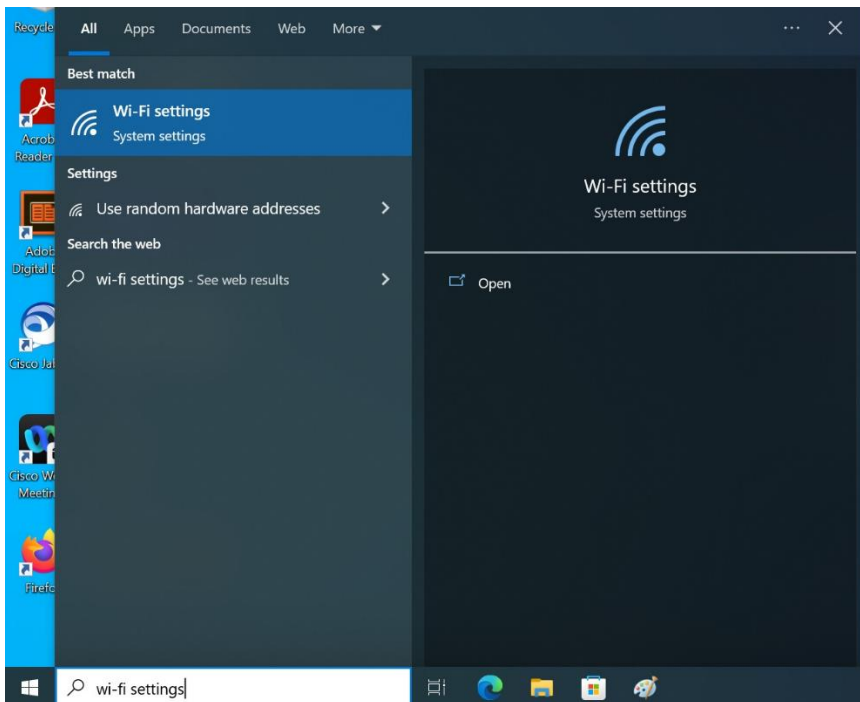


UWS Wireless Network

Connecting Windows 10 Devices to Wireless Network

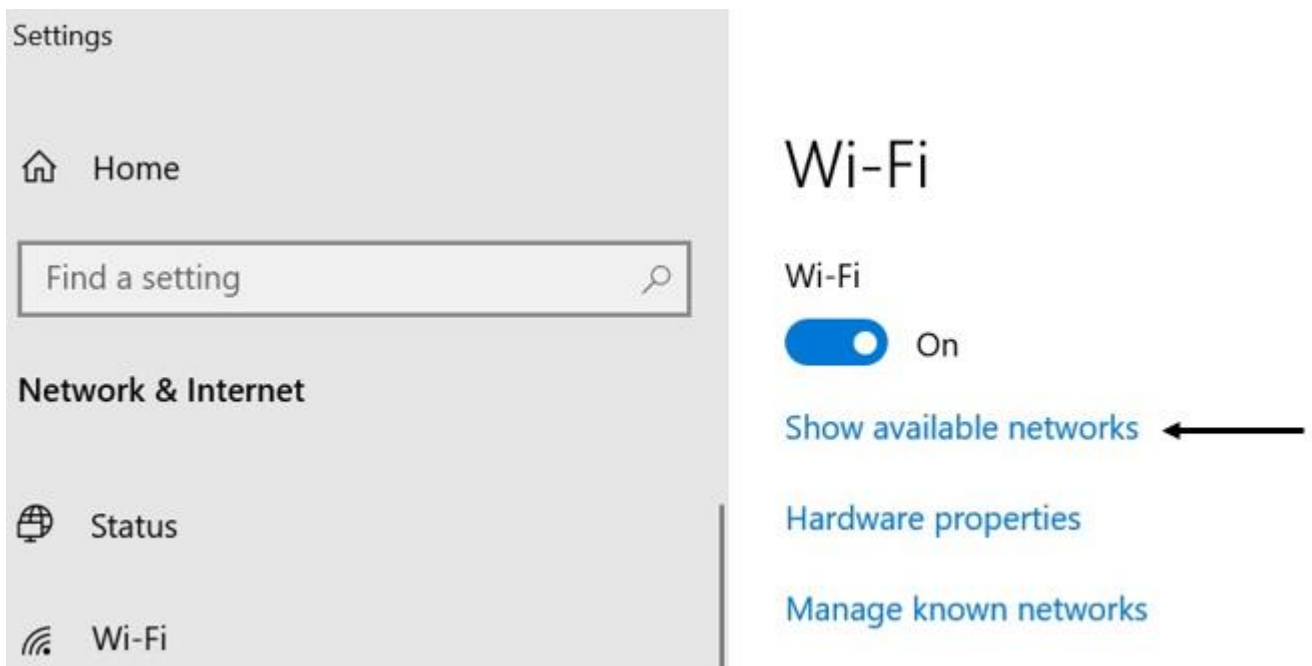
PLEASE NOTE IF YOUR LAPTOP HAS NORTON ANTI-VIRUS SOFTWARE IT WILL NOT CONNECT TO THE WIRELESS NETWORK IN THE UNIVERSITY.

Click on the Windows 10 start screen, type in “wi-fi settings” then click on “Open” on the found Wi-Fi Settings option.



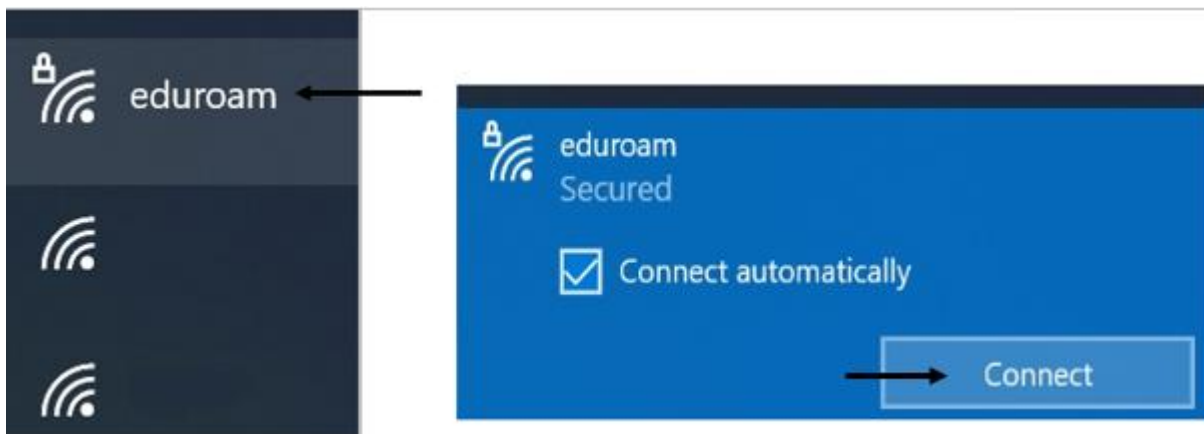
Windows 10 Start Screen

From the Wi-Fi Settings screen, click on “**Show available networks**”



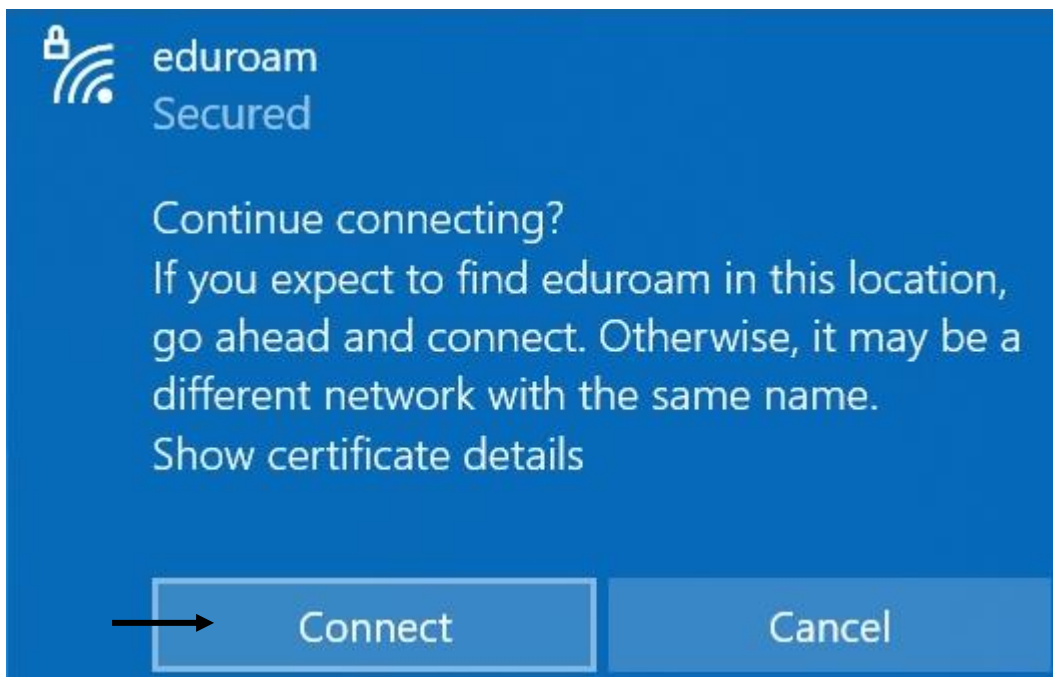
Wi-Fi Settings Screen

From the list of available networks click on “**eduroam**”, ensure “**Connect automatically**” is ticked and click on “**Connect**”.



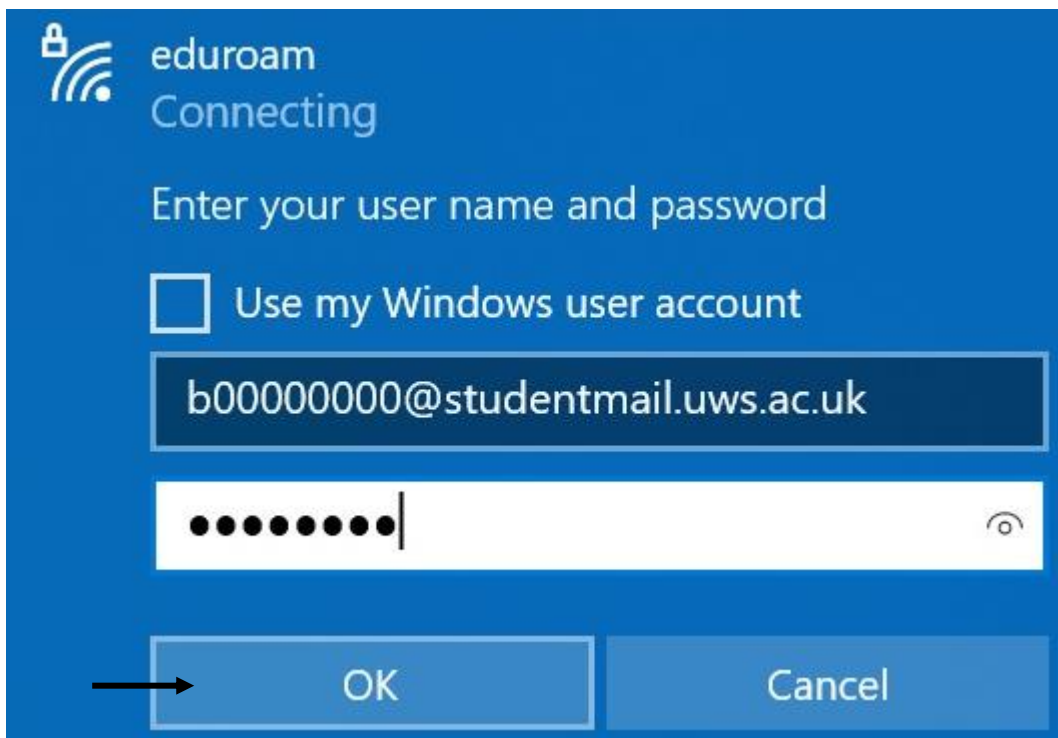
List of Available Networks Screens

Click on “**Connect**” to continue connecting



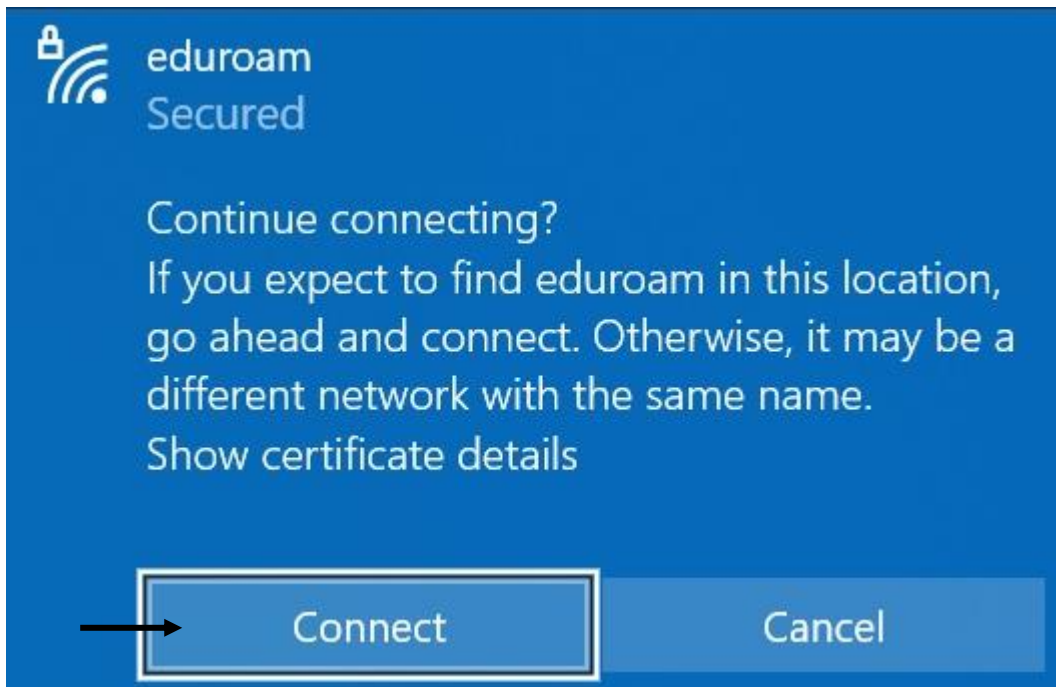
Continue Connecting Screen

For a student, enter your student email address in the format of **Bannerid@studentmail.uws.ac.uk** and your network/email password & click on “**OK**”



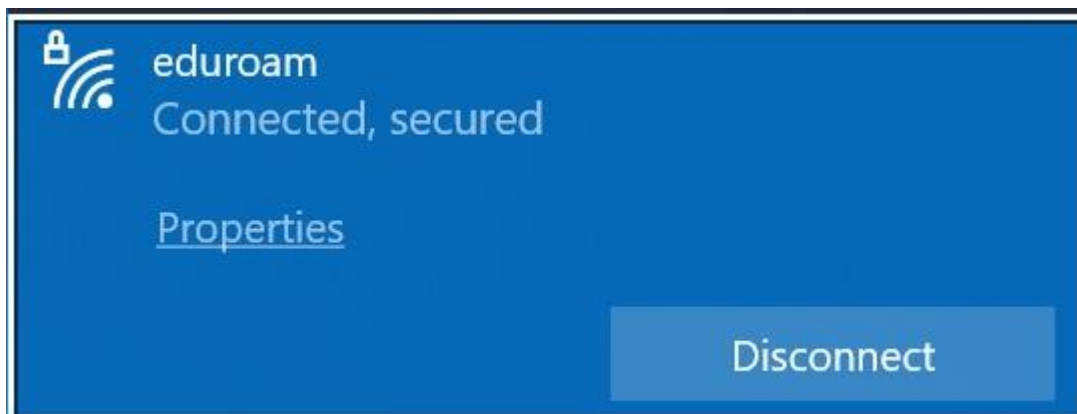
Student Details Login Screen

The system will now try and connect you to eduroam and if the student login details are correct, you will be successfully connected.




Student Successful Connection Screen

For a staff member, enter your staff email address in the format of **firstname.lastname@uws.ac.uk** and your network password & click on “**OK**”



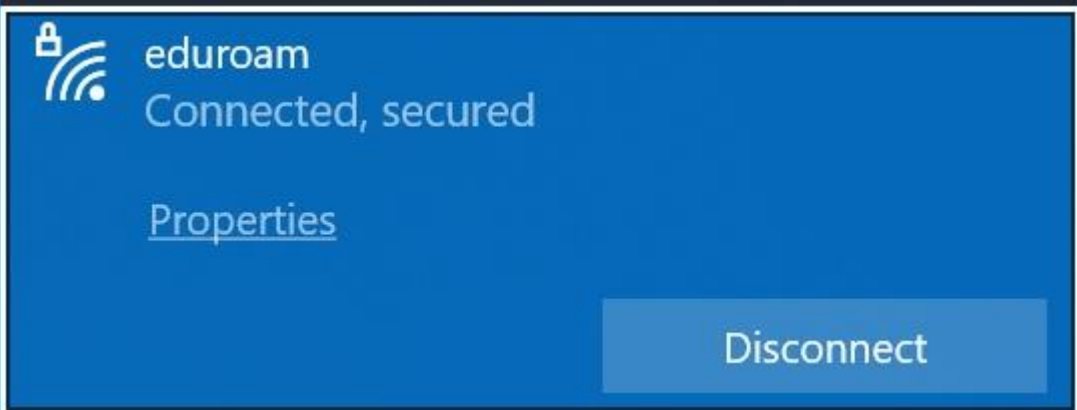
Staff Details Login Screen
