Our inclusive learning and teaching and assessment approaches, informed by the voice of our student community, are targeted to meet the skills needs of the places we serve and will maximise our students' success, by focusing on:

- Graduate skills, with all UWS degrees integrating professional skills for the workplace and essential knowledge and understanding of digital technologies and artificial intelligence
- Work-related learning, with all students benefitting from authentic assessment that measures real-world skills
- Work-based learning, with innovative learning models that enable students to combine full-time work with integrated study
- Pathways for modular, programmatic continuing professional development and degree study that will enable flexibility within a framework to coach students to success
- Wraparound student support to deliver a learner-centred approach, empowering students to understand their learning path, and empowering confidence to apply their skills, knowing that they are supported at all stages
