This fund provides a full-fees postgraduate scholarship to deserving applicants who identify as women. For our intake in September 2025, we are delighted to offer opportunities for application for postgraduate study across our School of Business and Creative Industries; School of Computing, Engineering and Physical Sciences; School of Education and Social Sciences; and School of Health and Life Sciences.

WHO WAS FRANCES WRIGHT?

Born in Dundee, Scotland, in 1795, Frances Wright became a US citizen in 1825. She was a visionary feminist, social reformer, and prolific writer. Throughout her life, she fearlessly challenged societal norms, advocating for women's rights, abolitionism, and educational reform. Frances Wright's courageous activism and groundbreaking ideas continue to inspire and influence movements for equality and justice around the world.

- Applicants should identify as women
